(Students must follow the actual course arrangements provided by the General Education Center when selecting courses. Additionally, course enrollment should be conducted in accordance with the "Student Course Selection Guidelines" set by the General Education Center. Any matters not covered shall be handled in accordance with the university's course selection regulations.)
- 本業業依校務會議審議通過後，其課程可放寬自102學年度入學學生之抵免學分及課程，如舊生之課程科目表與新生之課程科目表有所衝突時，需依「本校學生抵免科目學分辦法」及有利於學生畢業之權益優先採用之。  
(This proposal, upon approval by the university's Academic Affairs Committee, allows the curriculum to extend credit exemptions and course recognition to students who enrolled starting from the 102nd academic year. In cases where there are conflicts between the course schedules for current students and new students, the "University Regulations on Credit and Course Exemptions" shall apply, prioritizing policies that best support students' rights and interests for graduation.)
